LOCAL RULES

Additional Local Rules listed below to be read in conjunction with the Local Rules on the back of the score card.

- Distance Measuring devices permitted according to rule 14.3.
- Portable Sprinklers on the green to be treated as immovable obstructions and must be lifted no penalty nearest point of relief. Rule 24-b.
- GUR - defined by white lines. Drop ball no nearer the hole.
- Greenkeepers mess - debris piled for burning may be treated as GUR. Rule 25-1b (i)
- Freshly sodded grass areas are to be treated as GUR. Relief is drop the ball nearest point of relief but not nearer the hole
- Core Piles to be treated as GUR. Relief is drop the ball nearest point of relief but not nearer the hole
- Ant nests to be treated as GUR. Relief is drop the ball nearest point of relief but not nearer the hole
- Kangaroo footprints on the line of play may be repaired just like a pitch mark only if your ball is on the green.
- Kangaroo Prints in bunkers - a ball lying in a print may be lifted, the bunker raked and then the ball replaced as close to the original ball position/spot.
- Wheel marks (grounds machinery) relief can be taken through the green.
- The Clubhouse and Golf Shop are Out of Bounds.
- Ball lying on the practise putting green or paths near Clubhouse - relief must be taken using the drop zones alongside the 9th and 18th greens.
- Dams on the course are penalty areas.
- Tree Roots - If your ball is impeded by a tree root you may get relief. Relief is only for if the ball is lying on or if the swing path is impeded by the tree root. The ball can be dropped nearest point of relief but not nearer the hole.
